AN ACT

Relating to registration, bonds and insurance required of construction contractors; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.18.161(9) is amended to read:

(9) work on one project under one or more contracts, the aggregate contract price of which for labor and materials and all other items is less than \$10,000, this work being considered as of a casual, minor, or inconsequential nature; this exemption does not apply when the work is only a part of a larger or major operation, whether undertaken by the same or a different contractor, or when the work is divided into contracts of amounts less than \$10,000 for the purpose of evasion of this chapter or otherwise; this exemption does not apply to a person who advertises or puts out a sign or card or other device which might indicate to the public that he is a contractor, or that he is qualified to engage in the contracting business; a contractor who performs work priced at \$1,000 or more, under this exemption, shall nevertheless keep in force public liability and property damage insurance with coverage in at least the amounts set out in sec. 101 of this chapter;

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
