AN ACT

Relating to electrical safety.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.60.580 is amended to read:

Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The 1975 published edition of the National Electrical Code approved by the American Standards Association, and the latest published edition as of August 5, 1969 of the National Electrical Safety Code issued by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Standards, constitute the minimum electrical safety standards of the state.

* Sec. 2. AS 18.60.590(a) is amended to read:

(a) The department may by regulation adopt amendments to the 1975 National Electrical Code as approved and issued by the American Standards Association.
