AN ACT

Relating to eligibility requirements for elective municipal offices.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 29.23.130(b) is amended to read:

(b) A borough voter is eligible to be borough mayor. The assembly may by ordinance establish residence requirements for candidates for borough mayor not exceeding three years.

* Sec. 2. AS 29.23.200(b) is amended to read:

(b) A city voter is eligible to hold office as a member of the council. The council may by ordinance establish residence requirements for council members not exceeding three years. A council member who ceases to be eligible to be a city voter immediately forfeits that office.

* Sec. 3. AS 29.23.250(a) is amended to read:

(a) A voter of a home rule or general law city is eligible to hold the office of mayor, except that a home rule city may prescribe additional residency requirements by charter. The council, for all other cities, may by ordinance establish residence requirements for candidates for mayor not exceeding three years.
