AN ACT

Relating to toilet facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.35.100 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 18.35.100. TOILET FACILITIES REQUIRED. (a) An owner of a restaurant or tavern in operation on the effective date of this Act shall provide and maintain no less than one sanitary toilet accommodation for public use, and shall comply with this requirement within 180 days after the effective date of this Act.

(b) An owner of a restaurant or tavern shall provide and maintain sanitary toilet accommodations for public use.

* Sec. 2. AS 18.35.120 is amended to read:

Sec. 18.35.120. ENFORCEMENT. The department shall promulgate regulations to implement and enforce sec. 100 of this chapter by appropriate means. These regulations shall set standards of sanitation and shall provide for, but need not be limited to, periodic inspections. However, these regulations may not require a restaurant or tavern to have more than one toilet accommodation. A restaurant or tavern which is remodeled after the effective date of this Act is considered to be newly constructed.

* Sec. 3. AS 18.35.230 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(7) "remodeling" means any substantial modification of the physical structure or redesign and redecoration the value of which exceeds 10 per cent of the fair market value of the structure.
