## AN ACT

Relating to wage rates.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 36.05.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 36.05.010. WAGE RATES ON PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION. A contractor or subcontractor who performs work on public construction in the state, as defined by AS 36.95.010(3), shall pay not less than the current prevailing rate of wages for work of a similar nature in the region in which the work is done. The current prevailing rate of wages for each pay period is that contained in the latest determination of prevailing rate of wages issued by the Department of Labor before the end of the pay period.

\* Sec. 2. AS 36.05.070(a) is amended to read:

(a) The advertised specifications for a public construction contract exceeding \$2,000 to which the state or a political subdivision of the state is a party which requires or involves the employment of mechanics, laborers, or field surveyors shall contain a provision stating the minimum wages to be paid various classes of laborers, mechanics, or field surveyors and that the rate of wages shall be adjusted to the wage rate for each pay period applicable under sec. 10 of this chapter.

\* Sec. 3. AS 36.95.010(1) and (3) are amended to read:

(1) "contractor" means the contractor including subcontractors performing work necessary to facilitate public construction;

(3) "public construction" or "public works" means

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the on-site field surveying, erection, rehabilitation, alteration, extension or repair, including painting or redecorating buildings, highways or other improvements to real property under contract for the state or a political subdivision of the state;
