HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 109

Requesting the Alaska Bar Association to publicize the Attorney Fee Review Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS public attention has focused on the problems and processes related to the settlement and litigation of medical malpractice claims; and

WHEREAS one of the facets of that problem attracting wide public attention is the practice of the legal profession in accepting cases on a contingency fee basis; and

WHEREAS the public and the legal profession are benefited when fees for legal services are fair and equitable and the judicial system benefited by amicable settlement of fee disputes between attorneys and their clients; and

WHEREAS the Attorney Fee Review Committee of the Alaska Bar Association provides a mechanism to resolve fee disputes between attorneys and their clients;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Alaska Bar Association is hereby requested to undertake a state-wide effort to fairly inform the public of the existence, purposes and procedures of the Attorney Fee Review Committee.
