HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 116

Commending the contestants in the state small schools championship playoff.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the small schools state championship basketball playoff has recently culminated in a hairsbreadth victory by the Nome-Beltz Nanooks over a team from Fort Yukon; and

WHEREAS almost the entire population of Fort Yukon turned out to watch the final game of the three-game championship series; and

WHEREAS the Nanooks fought their way back into contention after losing by a single point in the second game the night before; and

WHEREAS the score in the final game was tied at the end of the first and second quarters of play; and

WHEREAS the Nanooks only edged ahead in the third and fourth quarters to win by a final score of 46-40; and

WHEREAS the final game was marked by fine play on the part of both teams, especially the Nanooks' defensive effort;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it congratulates the Nome-Beltz Nanooks on their state small schools championship, and further congratulates the Fort Yukon team, runnerup and champion of Region 2.
