HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 86

Relating to the repair of blacktopping of the City of Nome - Beltz High School complex road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the approximately four miles of road between the City of Nome and the Beltz High School complex is heavily used by residents and students; and

WHEREAS this four-mile stretch of road is a basically sound road, but the blacktopping has deteriorated to the point that significant hazards are created; and

WHEREAS in addition to the hazards, this deterioration is extremely harmful to vehicles using the road, thus creating an indirect, but very real cost;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Highways to repair the blacktopping on the road between the City of Nome and the Beltz High School complex during the 1976 construction season.
