## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 102

Establishing a toll-free telephone "hot line" within the legislature.

\*\*\*\*\*  
**BE IT RESOLVED**

**BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

WHEREAS during the legislative session the volume of public interest and inquiries on legislative activities is extremely high; and

WHEREAS information on many activities of both the Senate and House is not immediately available for public response; and

WHEREAS the cost of a toll-free telephone service would be tremendously outweighed by the benefits of public input to the legislative process;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature directs the Legislative Council to study the feasibility of establishing a toll-free telephone service in Juneau, enabling anyone in the State of Alaska to call at no charge to contact his legislator or to obtain legislative information. The study and its recommendations shall be presented to the legislature no later than January 10, 1977.
