SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 55

Honoring Roy A. Svendsen.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Roy A. Svendsen, an Alaska business and civic leader, has recently passed away; and

WHEREAS Roy Svendsen came to Alaska in 1941 to work for the Alaska Railroad; opened a grocery store; and worked for Action Vending Company for 18 years, serving for 10 of those years as manager and president; and

WHEREAS Roy Svendsen served in the Alaska Territorial National Guard from its creation at the beginning of World War II; and

WHEREAS Roy Svendson was a member of Elks Lodge 1351 for 33 years, a charter member of the Anchorage Kiwanis Club, and a member of the Pioneers of Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that its members, in expressing their sorrow to the members of his family, acknowledge Roy Svendsen's contribution to the business and civic life of Alaska.
