SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 60

Relating to assistance of the Legislature at the eighth annual Girls' State.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the eighth annual Girls' State program will be held on the campus and facilities of Alaska Methodist University at Anchorage, Alaska, June 6 - 12, 1976; and

WHEREAS at Girls' State the delegates learn the duties of the various offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the election of a legislature and the introduction and debate upon bills in accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

WHEREAS the Legislature, as in past years, could be of valuable aid to the operation of the Girls' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs Agency prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legislative process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members in attendance at Girls' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature directs the Legislative Council to authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency, within the limits of its appropriations, to assist in the preparation of legislative materials and, on the request of the Girls' State director, to have legislators designated by the presiding officer of each house and two Agency staff members attend the eighth annual Girls' State to aid the delegates in the legislative program.
