SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 72

Designating Alaska Centennial Salvation Army Week.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

The Legislature is pleased to take official note of the forthcoming Alaska Centennial Salvation Army Congress in Sitka, the week of April 8 - 11, 1976.
