SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 78

Paying tribute to the memory of C. A. (Bud) Weberg.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

C. A. (Bud) Weberg, one of Alaska's foremost fishery authorities, passed away on July 18, 1975.

Mr. Weberg, who held a degree in fishery management, spent twenty years managing Alaska's fisheries. He served as an Area Biologist from late 1955 to early 1962, six years as Director of the Division of Fish and Wildlife Protection, as Director of International Fisheries for the Governor's Office, and at the time of his death as Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety.

C. A. (Bud) Weberg effectively negotiated with foreign countries in behalf of Alaska's fisheries and more than anyone else brought Alaska's fish and wildlife law enforcement to its present professional status.

The members of the Alaska Legislature pay tribute to Mr. Weberg and his accomplishments and dedicated efforts in behalf of Alaska's fish and game resources, and express their sympathy to the family of C. A. (Bud) Weberg.
