SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 84

Requesting the Governor to direct the transfer of ownership of the state-owned health facility in Craig to the City of Craig.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the City of Craig wishes to contract for the services of a physician's assistant in order to provide basic medical services to the residents of Craig; and

WHEREAS the City of Craig cannot obtain such a contract until it acquires ownership of a health facility; and

WHEREAS the State of Alaska owns a health facility in Craig;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the transfer of the ownership of the state-owned health facility in Craig to the City of Craig with the condition that the property would revert to the state if it ceased to be used by the city as a health facility; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the transfer document guarantee continued availability of space for state medical personnel at no cost to the state.
