SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 86

Honoring George Attla for winning his sixth Fur Rendezvous championship.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Fur Rendezvous World Championship Sled Dog Race is a demanding test of sled dog racing skill; and

WHEREAS only mushers who are highly proficient in selecting, training and driving a team of dogs can expect to finish in the top five positions; and

WHEREAS George Attla on February 22, 1976, won his sixth victory in the annual Fur Rendezvous World Championship Sled Dog Race; and

WHEREAS George Attla won the race in spite of having undergone surgery only two months before the race;
