SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 95

Saluting Dr. Don M. Dafoe on the occasion of his retirement from public employment but not from public service.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

The University of Alaska has announced the retirement from service to the University of Dr. Don M. Dafoe who has played an active and productive role in all levels of educational endeavor in Alaska for 25 years, to wit:

Assistant superintendent of schools in Anchorage, 1951-52
Commissioner of Education, Territory of Alaska, 1953-59
Consultant for state schools systems, U.S. Office of Education, 1959-61
Superintendent of schools, Anchorage public school system, 1961-66
Provost, Southcentral Region, University of Alaska, 1966-69
Executive Secretary, Council of State School Officers, Washington, D.C., 1969-70
Vice President for Public Service, 1971-72, and then Executive Vice President, University of Alaska, 1973 to date, with retirement due on June 30 of this year.

The Legislature has long been alert to Dr. Dafoe's energetic espousal of education-oriented programs for Alaska as a territory and as a state. His formidable talents as an advocate and administrator have left their mark on the state's educational system.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Dr. Don

M. Dafoe has earned a cordial salute from the Legislature and the people of Alaska for his long public service in support of education. The Legislature salutes him and wishes him every success in his endeavors after retirement from his state position which will surely find him continuing in his service to the public.
