SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 45

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to the disposal or lease of state land or interest therein.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Article VIII, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska is amended to read:

SECTION 10. PUBLIC NOTICE AND LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL.
No disposals or leases of state lands, or interests therein, shall be made without prior public notice and other safeguards of the public interest as may be prescribed by law. The legislature may provide by law for the legislative approval of disposals, leases or other disposition of state lands or interests therein.

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
