AN ACT

Making miscellaneous appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$423,500 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Affairs Agency for the additional expenses of the First Session, Tenth Legislature incurred during the remainder of fiscal year 1977.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$269,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Affairs Agency for Legislative Council expenses and Alaska Code Commission projects. The unexpended and unencumbered balance of this appropriation lapses into the general fund on June 30, 1978.

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$7,600 is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative finance division for the additional expenses of the First Session, Tenth Legislature incurred during the remainder of fiscal year 1977.

* Sec. 4. The sum of \$400,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the agricultural development project revolving fund for fiscal year 1978 and the remainder of fiscal year 1977, for the purpose of surveying, clearing, and breaking 2,000 acres of land, and clean-up of burn residue, to test the production of feed grains on a commercial scale in the Delta-Clearwater-Tanana Loop, and for a baseline data study for the project.

* Sec. 5. The sum of \$20,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Fish and Game, game management, for fiscal year 1978 contractual expenses of the upland game bird program.

* Sec. 6. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Works for an airstrip feasibility study at the village of Atka.

* Sec. 7. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
