AN ACT

Making appropriations for miscellaneous purposes; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of ~~\$9,100,202~~ ^{\$8,889,202} is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977, to be allocated as follows:

Foundation Program - Regular	\$1,956,733
Foundation Program - REAA's	2,638,000
Pupil Transportation - Regular	2,163,100
Local Formula - REAA's	1,217,470
AVEC and other	615,000
Safe Water	103,000
Audit Exception - Vocational Education	15,889
Bering Strait REAA	400,000 ^{100,000}

* Sec. 2. The sum of ~~\$1,731,400~~ ^{\$1,287,000} is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978 to be allocated as follows:

Major maintenance projects having a cost in excess of \$10,000 such as, but not limited to, roof repair, water and sewer improvement, fire and life safety, boilers, power generators and correction of building code deficiencies - REAA'S ^{\$1,066,000} \$3,216,400

Survey of existing REAA facilities for cost of correcting life safety and other deficiencies of the facilities ^{\$100,000} 215,000

* Sec. 3. The sum of ~~\$150,000~~ is appropriated from the

general fund to the Office of the Governor for the Bodily Injury Reparation Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978.

* Sec. 4. The sum of \$2,533,200 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Administration for the teachers' retirement system match for fiscal years ending June 30, 1976, and June 30, 1977.

* Sec. 5. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the University of Alaska to fund the costs of professional managers and consultants retained by the University of Alaska during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977.

* Sec. 6. Sections 1, 4 and 5 of this Act take effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c). Sections 2 and 3 of this Act take effect July 1, 1977.
