Approving the contract for the sculpting of a statue of Senator Ernest Gruening for placement in the National Statuary Hall of the U.S. Capitol.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, by approval of ch. 186, SLA 1975, the Legislature authorized the Alaska State Council on the Arts to contract for the construction of a life-sized statue of Senator Ernest Gruening to be ultimately placed in the National Statuary Hall of the U.S. Capitol; and

WHEREAS the contract for the services of a sculptor was subject to the approval of Mrs. Dorothy Gruening and the Legislature; and

WHEREAS the contract for a representational statue of Senator Gruening has been approved by Mrs. Gruening and the Alaska State Council on the Arts, and the work of the artist George R. Anthonisen is underway;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature by the adoption of this resolution approves of the contract signed by the Alaska State Council on the Arts for the construction of the statue authorized by ch. 186, SLA 1975.
