Relating to conducting the business of the district courts after normal working hours.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the business of the district courts of the State of Alaska requires that a substantial number of the public personally appear in court or in the office of the court clerk; and

WHEREAS appearance in court involves substantial hardship for those persons who are otherwise needed at home or at work;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully requests the supreme court to ascertain what business of the district courts, if conducted after normal working hours, would further the convenience of the largest number of people and to direct the district courts to conduct that business after normal working hours.
