Congratulating the Chugiak-Eagle River Star.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Chugiak-Eagle River Star has been named a "National Blue Ribbon Newspaper" for 1977 by the National Editorial Foundation; and

WHEREAS the Star is one of 332 papers nationwide to receive the coveted designation; and

WHEREAS the Foundation uses 25 criteria in an evaluation to measure a newspaper's service to the community against a national standard; and

WHEREAS the Star received the maximum number of points in its coverage of community news concerning local governments, school activities, local businesses, youth activities, special interest groups such as minority groups and political parties, local sports, civic events, religious activities, letters to the editor, and feature photographs; and

WHEREAS it also rated high in professional membership, service to the community, departmentalization of news, locally written editorials, advertising and overall appearance;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature congratulates the Chugiak-Eagle River Star and hopes that it will continue to provide such fine service to Eagle River and the rest of the state.
