Honoring Ruth Anderson, Beatrice Shepard and Herman Trivette.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS on May 31, 1977, Ruth Anderson, Beatrice Shepard and Herman Trivette will retire from service with the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services; and

WHEREAS Ruth Anderson moved to Alaska in 1943 to accept employment as a teacher in the public school system, moved to a position with the Territorial Department of Health in 1947, and since that time has been employed by the department, presently as Chief of the Graphic Arts Section of the Administrative Services Division; and

WHEREAS Beatrice Shepard moved to Alaska in 1946 to accept a position as a bacteriologist with the Territorial Department of Health, and has served the department from the beginning, presently as Supervisor of the Southeastern Regional Laboratory; and

WHEREAS Herman Trivette moved to Alaska in 1954 and accepted an appointment with the Department of Health as Director of the Division of Accounting and Business Management in 1956 and has served since that time, presently in the Division of Administrative Services as the department's Expenditure Control Officer; and

WHEREAS the combined total service of these public servants to Alaska and Alaskans exceeds 80 years;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature, on behalf of itself and all other Alaskans, that it expresses its collective thanks to Ruth Anderson, Beatrice Shepard and Herman Trivette for jobs well done and extends its very best wishes

for continued success in future endeavors.
