Urging the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration to provide funding for a legal process study.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the Alaska Court System has designed a project calling for the development of new methods and procedures in the judicial system aimed toward making the system less complex and costly and more responsive to the needs of the public for dispute resolution mechanisms; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Court System has submitted a proposal for funding of the project to the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration; and

WHEREAS the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration recently sent a task force to Alaska to investigate the feasibility of implementing this proposal in Alaska and this task force has concluded that Alaskans would be receptive to the changes that may be developed in the course of the project;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Senate finds that this project would contribute to the administration of justice in Alaska and urges the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration to provide necessary funding.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Warren E. Burger, Chief Justice, U. S. Supreme Court; the Honorable Richard W. Velde, Administrator, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration; to the Alaska Governor's Commission on the Administration of Justice; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
