## AN ACT

Adding to the powers and duties of the office of alcoholism.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 47.37.030(2) is amended to read:

(2) make contracts and award grants necessary or incidental to the performance of its duties and the execution of its powers, including contracts with and grants to public and private agencies, organizations, and individuals, to pay them for services rendered or furnished to alcoholics or intoxicated persons; to the maximum extent possible, contracts and grants shall be for a period of two years;

\* Sec. 2. AS 47.37.040(7) is amended to read:

(7) organize and foster training programs for all persons engaged in treatment of alcoholics and intoxicated persons and establish standards for training paraprofessional alcoholism workers;

\* Sec. 3. AS 47.30.470(4) is amended to read:

(4) identify, and utilize whatever facilities and services are available or can be made available through community organization for carrying out the purposes of this section, including identification and utilization for detoxification of under-utilized hospital beds;

\* Sec. 4. AS 47.37.040 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

(18) develop and implement a training program on alcoholism for employees of state and municipal governments,

(19) develop curriculum materials on drug and alcohol abuse for use in grades kindergarten through 12, as well as a course of instruction for teachers to be charged with presenting the curriculum.
