AN ACT

Making a special appropriation to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, interior division, for delineation of a utility corridor and railroad right-of-way for extension of the Alaska Railroad; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$865,000* is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, interior division, for the purpose of reconnaissance photography and studies, field surveys, mapping, engineering work, cost comparisons, and office work to delineate a utility corridor and railroad right-of-way for extension of the Alaska Railroad to the Canadian border.

* Sec. 2. The unexpended and unobligated portion of this appropriation lapses into the general fund June 30, 1979.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).

* The amount appropriated in Sec. 1 was reduced by the governor to \$150,000 and, as reduced, approved by the governor on June 18, 1977, effective June 19, 1977 (ch. 150 SLA 1977). The governor's reduction of the appropriation by \$715,000 was overridden by the legislature on January 13, 1978, and as to the \$715,000, this Act is effective January 14, 1978.
