AN ACT

Making special appropriations to the Department of Health and Social Services for lump sum grants to alcoholism programs in the state; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$40,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health and Social Services to be paid as a lump sum grant to the National Council on Alcoholism-Alaska Region, Inc. for alcoholism prevention and education.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$5,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health and Social Services to be paid as a lump sum grant to the Petersburg City Council for the alcoholism program in Petersburg.

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$58,500 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health and Social Services to be paid as a lump sum grant to the City of Bethel for the Bethel Alcoholism Treatment Facility.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
