AN ACT

Making a special appropriation to the Department of Natural Resources and the Steering Council on Alaska Lands for site planning, design, engineering or acquisition of campground accommodations on the Skagway-Carcross highway and for a film on public land in Alaska; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$98,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Natural Resources for the purpose of funding site planning, design, engineering or acquisition of campground accommodations necessitated by visitation to Klondike-Gold Rush National Historic Park via the new Skagway-Carcross state highway.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Steering Council on Alaska Lands for the purpose of producing a film to inform the Alaska public on the distribution and status of public land in Alaska and to purchase commercial television time for broadcasting of the film.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
