AN ACT

Relating to the annual report of the State Commission for Human Rights.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.80.150 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 18.80.150. ANNUAL REPORT. The commission shall report annually to the governor and the legislature on civil rights problems it has encountered in the preceding year, and may recommend legislative action. The commission shall provide the Legislative Affairs Agency with 100 copies of the report during the week preceding the convening of the annual legislative session for legislator and library distribution. The commission shall make copies of the report available to the public.

* Sec. 2. AS 18.80.060(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(6) make an overall assessment, at least once every three years, of the progress made toward equal employment opportunity by every department of state government. Results of the assessment shall be included in the annual report made under sec. 150 of this chapter.
