AN ACT

Relating to the Alaska longevity bonus and to admission to the Alaska Pioneers' Home; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.45.010(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who is 65 years of age or over, who was domiciled in the territory on or before January 3, 1959 and who has maintained a continuous domicile in the territory or state for 25 years may apply to the commissioner of administration for qualification to receive a monthly bonus of \$150.

* Sec. 2. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 47.25.035. EXCEPTION TO ADMISSION CRITERIA. An applicant for admission to the home who has been a resident of the state for 30 years and is otherwise qualified for admission under sec. 20 or 30 of this chapter may not be disqualified for admission because of absence from the state if the commissioner of administration determines the absence was reasonable, and admission is consistent with the intent of this chapter.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1978.
