Relating to Alaskan participation in the Western States Legislative Forestry Task Force.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the forest industries of the State of Alaska play a vital and significant role in the economic well-being and development of the state; and

WHEREAS there is a present need for developing the means for protecting and fostering these forest industries so as to maximize the forest's yield while at the same time protecting and renewing the resource for future generations; and

WHEREAS the concerns of Alaska are largely identical to the concerns of other western states in this matter; and

WHEREAS the legislatures of the states of California, Idaho, Montana, Oregon and Washington have joined together to form the Western States Legislative Forestry Task Force; and

WHEREAS the Western States Legislative Forestry Task Force acts as a clearinghouse for opinion for the various interests involved in the forest industries of the western states and reports to the legislatures of the western states regarding means of protecting and fostering the forest industries of the member states;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the State of Alaska join the Western States Legislative Forestry Task Force; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the senate is requested to appoint two senators and the speaker of the house of representatives is requested to appoint two members of the house of representatives to represent Alaska on the Western

States Legislative Forestry Task Force.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the presiding officers of the legislatures of California, Idaho, Montana, Oregon and Washington.
