Declaring a "Day of Hope".

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaska faces problems of great magnitude in the areas of service to the mentally retarded and handicapped citizens of the state; and

WHEREAS Hope Cottages, Inc. is the largest not-for-profit community based organization dedicated to providing homes and quality programs to these Alaskans so that they can obtain the care and treatment available in Anchorage to enable them to develop their maximum potential socially as well as mentally; and

WHEREAS total citizen involvement throughout the state is desirable and essential; and

WHEREAS Hope Cottages, Inc. is sponsoring its ninth annual Walk for Hope in Anchorage and other Alaskan communities to raise funds for the continuing of services for the mentally retarded and disabled citizens of our state residing in the Hope Cottages, Inc. facilities, and all of the money raised will remain in Alaska to enhance this cause; and

WHEREAS Alaskan legislators have continuously supported the Walk for Hope in past years,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges all citizens of our great state to participate, thereby showing their concern for less fortunate citizens, in the ninth annual Walk for Hope to be held on May 6, 1978; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to proclaim May 6, 1978 a "Day of Hope".
