AN ACT

Relating to the refund of the unused balance of personal leave upon termination from state employment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Relating to the refund of the unused balance of personal
leave upon termination from state employment.

* Section 1. AS 39.20.250 is amended to read:

(a) Terminal leave for unused personal leave shall be allowed [AS A LUMP SUM] upon separation from service. The [LUMP-SUM] payment equals the compensation that the officer or employee would have received if he had remained in the service until the expiration of the period of unused personal leave. A payment of terminal leave to an employee shall be made as a lump sum payment or in installments over a period of time, as the employee elects.

(b) If the officer or employee is re-employed in the state service before the expiration of the period covered by the balance of the unused leave payment, he shall refund to the state an amount equal to the leave payment [COMPENSATION] covering the period between the date of re-employment and the expiration of the unused leave period which has been paid to him. The leave represented by a refund shall be re-credited to the officer or employee by the employing department or agency.

(c) The [LUMP-SUM] payment authorized by this section is not considered salary or compensation except for purposes of taxation.
