AN ACT

Relating to trapping license receipts; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.110(1) is amended to read:

(1) money received from the sale of state sport fishing, [AND] hunting, and trapping licenses and special permits;

* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.130 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.130. DIVERSION OF FUNDS PROHIBITED. No funds accruing to the state from sport fishing, [AND] hunting, and trapping licenses or permit fees may be diverted to a purpose other than the protection, propagation, investigation, and restoration of sport fish and game resources and the expenses of administering of the sport fish and game divisions of the department.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1979.
