* Section 1. AS 09.10.140 is amended to read:

Sec. 09.10.140. DISABILITIES OF MINORITY, INCOMPETENCY [INSANITY],
AND IMPRISONMENT. If a person entitled to bring an action mentioned in
this chapter is at the time the cause of action accrues either (1) under
the age of majority [19 YEARS], or (2) incompetent by reason of mental
illness, [INSANE] or (3) imprisoned on a criminal charge, or in execu-
tion under sentence of a court for a term less than his natural life,
the time of the disability is not a part of the time limited for the
commencement of the action. But the period within which the action may
be brought is not extended in any case longer than two years after the
disability ceases.
