Urging the Governor to direct the commissioner of administration to negotiate no salary or benefit increases which do not meet specified criteria.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the salaries and benefits of most state employees have more than kept pace with inflation; and

WHEREAS, however, the salaries of some state employees have fallen far behind increases in the cost of living; and

WHEREAS the legislature intends to fund no salary or benefit increases henceforth negotiated for those employees whose salary ranges during the immediately preceding four years have exceeded increases in the cost of living until the salaries of all other state employees are adjusted to at least meet cost-of-living impact for the same prior four years;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the Governor to direct the commissioner of administration to negotiate no salary or benefit increases which do not meet these criteria.
