Relating to utilization of "flex time" for state employees.

---

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS "flex time" is a system of allowing for alternate scheduling of employees' working hours which is potentially beneficial to both employees and the employer; and

WHEREAS "flex time" may be utilized to provide better and more efficient service to the public through expanded office hours, improved communication between different time zones, and more efficient use of costly equipment; and

WHEREAS "flex time" can be a significant factor in enhancing employee morale and productivity by allowing a greater range of personal preference; and

WHEREAS staggered starting hours could help relieve traffic congestion problems for state employees and the general public alike; and

WHEREAS some state agencies have already begun using "flex time" arrangements through the collective bargaining process;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to pursue a policy of granting state employees the option of flexible working hours, through the bargaining process and otherwise, if and only if this policy shows promise of providing better and more efficient service to the citizens of the state.
