## AN ACT

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

\* Section 1. AS 16.05.251(a)(8) is amended to read:

(8) investigating and determining the extent and effect of disease, predation, and competition among fish in the state, exercising control measures considered necessary to the resources of the state;

\* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.251(a)(10) is amended to read:

(10) prohibiting and regulating the live capture, possession, transport, or release of native or exotic fish or their eggs;

\* Sec. 3. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 16.05.868. FISH HEALTH INSPECTIONS. Fish health inspections determined to be necessary by the department shall be performed by a professional fish health specialist certified by the fish health section of the American Fisheries Society.

\* Sec. 4. AS 16.10.460 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) The cost of an inspection performed by the department under AS 16.10.400 - 16.10.470 shall be borne by the department.

\* Sec. 5. AS 16.10.420(9) is repealed.
