Giving the supreme court authority over court facilities; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 22.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 22.05.025. COURT FACILITIES. (a) The supreme court has authority over all matters relating to the planning, design, construction, maintenance, occupancy, and operation of all court facilities and shall cooperate and coordinate with the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities so that court facility construction projects are carried out in accordance with the statutes and regulations applicable to state public works projects.

(b) In this section, "court facility" means a state facility in which 75 percent or more of the net usable space is occupied by the court system and other justice-related agencies.

* Sec. 2. AS 35.05.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 35.05.010. PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION. The department is responsible for the planning and construction of public works except as provided for court facilities in AS 22.05.025.

* Sec. 3. This Act terminates June 30, 1982.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
