**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

Relating to community schools; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. AS 14.36.010(b) is amended to read:

(b) It is the intent of the legislature that

(1) a program of community school grants be established to provide assistance to local communities in the initial development, [AND] implementation, and operation of community school programs;

(2) technical assistance, monitoring, training, and coordination of statewide efforts to develop and operate community school programs be provided by the department; and

(3) the community school program will become fully operational once a plan of operation has been approved by the commissioner; [AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SECOND FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING ITS AUTHORIZATION]

(4) evaluation of the approved plan of operation for a community school program shall be conducted by the department in co-operation with the school district at least once every four years; a report of the community school programs evaluated in the preceding year shall be presented by the commissioner to the legislature before the 15th day of each regular session of the legislature.

Sec. 14.36.030. GRANTS FROM THE STATE. (a) A district operating a community school program under an approved plan of operation may receive an annual grant from the state of one-half of one percent of

1 its public school foundation support or \$10,000, whichever is greater.

2 (b) For each fiscal year beginning after June 30, 1980, a district  
3 operating an approved community school program under (a) of this section  
4 may receive a further grant from the state equal to the amount allocated  
5 by the district to the support of the community school program from  
6 sources other than the grant provided under (a) of this section. The  
7 additional grant under this subsection may not exceed the amount  
8 received under (a) of this section.

9 (c) The support of a community school program by a district under  
10 (b) of this section may be in cash or in kind. Cash support may be  
11 derived from any source the district considers appropriate. In kind  
12 support by a district is limited to support for purposes which benefit  
13 only the community school program. Cash and in kind support of the  
14 community school program by a district shall be itemized in the com-  
15 munity education section of the district budget.

20 SCHOOL DISTRICT,] an application for a community school grant. An
