AN ACT

Making special appropriations to various departments and agencies and the University of Alaska; and amending certain appropriations made in 1980; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of ~~\$4,938,419~~^{500,000} is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety for emergency medical services.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$1,454,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for operation of state contract schools.

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Office of the Governor for a media effort on national lands legislation.

* Sec. 4. The sum of \$700,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Council for the joint gas pipeline committee interim expenses.

~~* Sec. 5. The sum of \$390,000 is appropriated from the renewable resources development fund to the Alaska Agricultural Action Council for a reindeer disease control study.~~

* Sec. 6. The sum of \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for full funding of fiscal year 1981 municipal revenue sharing.

~~* Sec. 7. The sum of \$30,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety to purchase an ambulance for the community of Central.~~

* Sec. 8. The sum of \$298,900 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs as municipal lands trustee

for the section 14(c), Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act land program operations.

~~* Sec. 9. The sum of \$1,995,700 is appropriated from the general fund to the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission to create an Alaska fisheries data center.~~

~~* Sec. 10. The sum of \$29,000 is appropriated from the general fund for payment as a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage for the Chugiak Benefit Association.~~

~~* Sec. 11. The sum of \$25,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education, Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission, for an earth station and mini TV transmitter for Port Alexander.~~

~~* Sec. 12. The sum of \$56,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the University of Alaska, Anchorage Community College, for an Eagle River extension center.~~

* Sec. 13. The sum of \$109,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the University of Alaska, Kenai Peninsula Community College, for remodeling cost overruns.

* Sec. 14. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Council for economic studies.
