## AN ACT

Amending, adjusting, and repealing appropriations; making special appropriations to the Department of Education, the Department of Commerce and Economic Development, the Department of Labor, the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, the Department of Public Safety, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, the Legislative Council, and the University of Alaska, and for grants to municipalities for various purposes; and providing for an effective date.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**
