Making appropriations to the Alaska Power Authority for power projects; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

THE ACT FOLLOWS ON PAGE 1, LINE 10

Actual Effective Date: June 5, 1980

AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Alaska Power Authority for power projects; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. The sum of ~~\$19,250,000~~ ^{JH # 13,705,000} is appropriated from the renewable resources development fund, and the sum of \$11,835,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Alaska Power Authority to be allocated for the following projects:

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$3,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Alaska Power Authority power project revolving fund (AS 44.56.170) to be allocated as loans for the following projects:

* Sec. 4. Nonrenewable resource programs and projects funded in this Act are funded from the appropriations from the general fund.
