\* Section 1. AS 23.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 23.30.237. HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN WORK-STUDY PROGRAMS. An individual who is enrolled for credit at a public high school in a course which combines academic instruction with work experience outside the school for a public or private nonprofit employer is an employee of the state for the purposes of this chapter while he is performing the work experience. Weekly compensation for disability or death under this section may not be less than the initial payment of compensation under AS 23.30.175.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1980.
