Requesting the governor to urge the United States Department of Labor to establish a Job Corps Center in the state.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the United States Department of Labor has previously identified a possible need for a Job Corps Center in the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS the United States Department of Labor may now be considering establishing a Job Corps Center in the state; and

WHEREAS a Job Corps Center offers young people the opportunity to participate in programs which include training in job skills, career information, and work habits; and

WHEREAS the establishment of a Job Corps Center would create up to 80 positions for instructors and generate numerous jobs in the private sector; and

WHEREAS failure by the state to clearly express its support for the establishment of a Job Corps Center in the state may mean that the United States Department of Labor will not decide to establish a Job Corps Center and that the state will lose these potential benefits;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the governor to urge the United States Department of Labor to establish a Job Corps Center in Alaska.
