Relating to the installation of a visual approach slope indicator at the airport at Seward, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the use of a visual approach slope indicator (VASI) system greatly enhances safety at an airport during the landing of aircraft; and

WHEREAS the airport at Seward, Alaska, presently operates without a VASI system; and

WHEREAS the risks in marginal weather aircraft operation would be reduced and the safety of persons and property enhanced by a VASI system; and

WHEREAS other similarly situated airports in Alaska have VASI equipment;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the Federal Aviation Administration to install a visual approach slope indicator at the airport in Seward, Alaska, at the earliest possible moment.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to Mr. Langhorne M. Bond, Administrator, Federal Aviation Administration; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
