Relating to the Inuit Circumpolar Conference.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Government of Greenland is hosting the Second General Assembly of the Inuit Circumpolar Conference June 28 - July 4, 1980, in Nuuk, Kalatdlit Nunat (formerly Greenland); and

WHEREAS the Second General Assembly of the Inuit Circumpolar Conference will serve to strengthen cultural and economic ties with Denmark, our North American Arctic neighbor; and

WHEREAS the legislature recognizes the historical importance of the Second General Assembly of the Inuit Circumpolar Conference and its importance to the political and economic development of the Arctic; and

WHEREAS all Alaskans will benefit from the political and economic cooperation sought through the Inuit Circumpolar Conference; and

WHEREAS the Honorable Eben Hopson, Mayor of the North Slope Borough, a member of the last territorial legislature, a leader in Alaska's first Senate, and Chairman of the Inuit Circumpolar Conference, has worked hard over the past decade to organize the Inuit Circumpolar Conference;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature extends its congratulations to Mayor Eben Hopson for organizing the Second General Assembly of the Inuit Circumpolar Conference; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature will send a delegation of state legislators to the Second General Assembly of the Inuit Circumpolar Conference to meet with Greenland's governmental leaders and to attend the conference.
