Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to the appointment and confirmation of members of state boards and commissions.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Article III, sec. 26, Constitution of the State of Alaska is repealed and readopted to read:

Section 26. CONFIRMATION AND TERM OF OFFICE.

Unless otherwise provided by law, the governor shall appoint the members of all state boards and commissions, and the members may be removed as provided by law. Unless confirmation is otherwise provided for in this article, the legislature shall determine which state board and commission members are subject to confirmation by the legislature. Confirmation of board and commission members subject to confirmation under this section shall be by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session.

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
