Relating to the senior citizen tax exemption.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS in 1972 the legislature enacted AS 29.53.020(e), making any real property owned and occupied as a permanent place of abode by a qualifying resident 65 years of age or over exempt from municipal property tax; and

WHEREAS the legislature intended that the entire parcel of land owned by a resident 65 years of age or over be exempted from municipal property taxation, regardless of size;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that real property owned and occupied as a permanent place of abode by a qualifying resident 65 years of age or over shall be exempt from municipal property tax in its entirety regardless of size.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the governor, the commissioner of community and regional affairs, and each municipality in Alaska.
