AN ACT

Establishing a special aid program for providing special education programs during the summer of 1981; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AID PROGRAM FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION PROVIDED DURING THE SUMMER. (a) A school district or regional educational attendance area that provides special services to exceptional children identified under AS 14.30.350(1)(A), (B), (C), (D) and (F) during the summer of 1981 may receive aid under this section by filing an application with the Department of Education.

(b) The commissioner of education may approve aid to an applicant under this section in an amount up to 33 percent of the state aid that

(1) the applicant qualified for during the 1980-1981 school year; and

(2) was calculated under AS 14.17.041(f) for services to exceptional children identified under AS 14.30.350(1)(A), (B), (C), (D), and (F).

(c) The Department of Education shall

(1) provide forms for applying under this section;

(2) disburse aid under this section that has been approved by the commissioner of education.

* Sec. 2. This Act is repealed September 1, 1981.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
